



Lift Your Voice for the Season! A Festive Holiday Carolling Deep Dive



Art Studio is a safe space for students to explore and have fun. Students will engage in daily artwork analysis to practice expanding their critical and observational skills and to understand the evolution of the art world throughout historical periods. Students will be assigned 1 main art project throughout the 2 weeks. The project will promote students' creativity with unconventional mediums and practice the principles and elements of design within art. Through the creation of this process, it will challenge the students to think critically to resolve barriers and to build on resiliency, perseverance, and patience. Students will have the freedom to explore and advocate for their artistic expression and will be encouraged to take creative risks. Artworks will be displayed on the last day of deep dive to showcase the students' effort and creativity.

Video Game Music and **Sound Design**

- Create a quilt to donate to local community charities, such as Chilliwack Hospice,
 Meadow Rose Society, and the Child Development Centre, as well as a smaller quilted piece for you to keep!


